

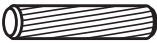
Examine all packaging material for small parts that may have come loose during shipment. Periodic checks are recommended to insure that all components are in proper position, tight and free from damage. Keep this assembly instruction for future reference. Adult assembly is required.

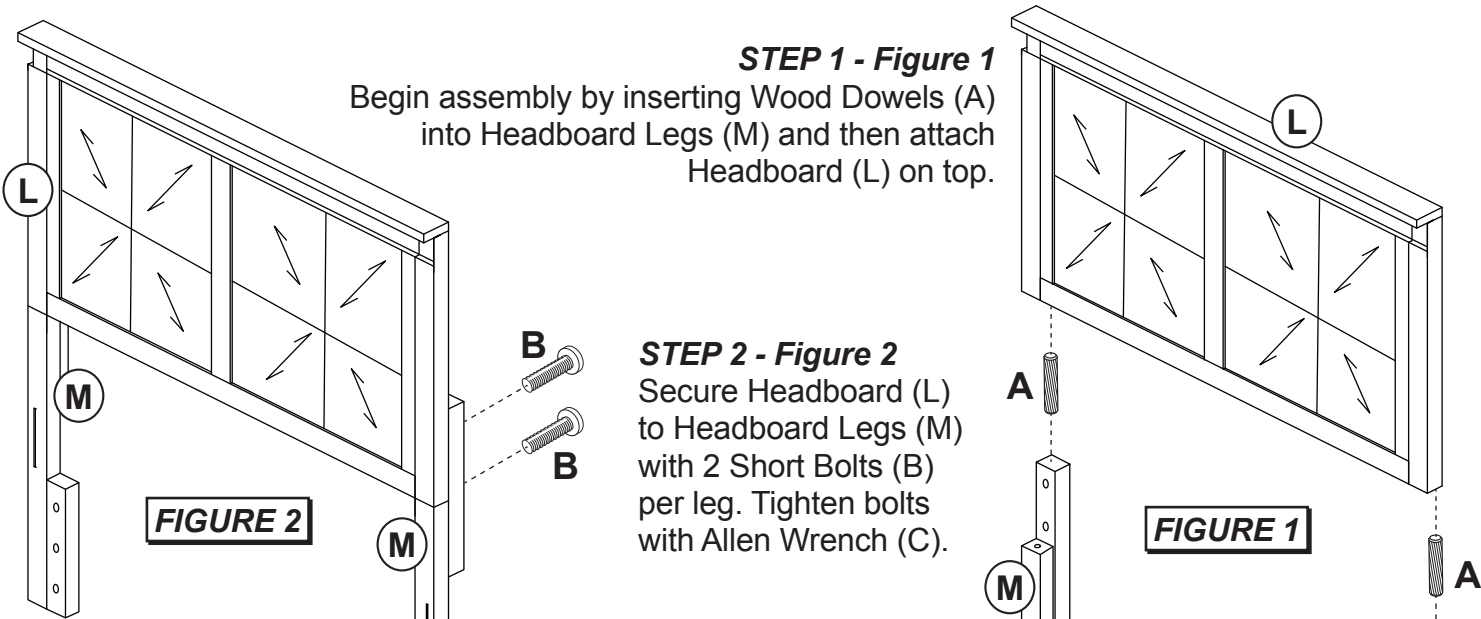

STEP 1 - Figure 1

Begin assembly by inserting Wood Dowels (A) into Headboard Legs (M) and then attach Headboard (L) on top.

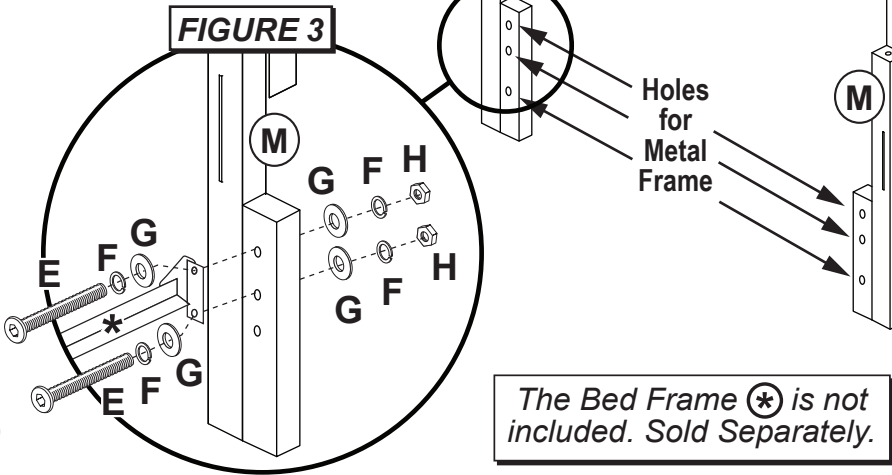


STEP 2 - Figure 2

Secure Headboard (L) to Headboard Legs (M) with 2 Short Bolts (B) per leg. Tighten bolts with Allen Wrench (C).

STEP 3 - Figure 3 For Metal Frame

Secure Metal Frame (*Not Included) to the Headboard Legs (M) with 2 Long Bolts (E), 2 Spring Washers (F) and 2 Flat Washers (G) from the front of each leg and 2 Flat Washers (G), 2 Spring Washers (F) and 2 Hex Nuts (H) from the back of each leg.

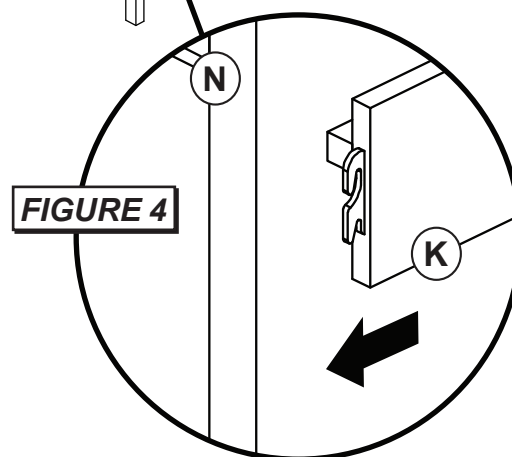
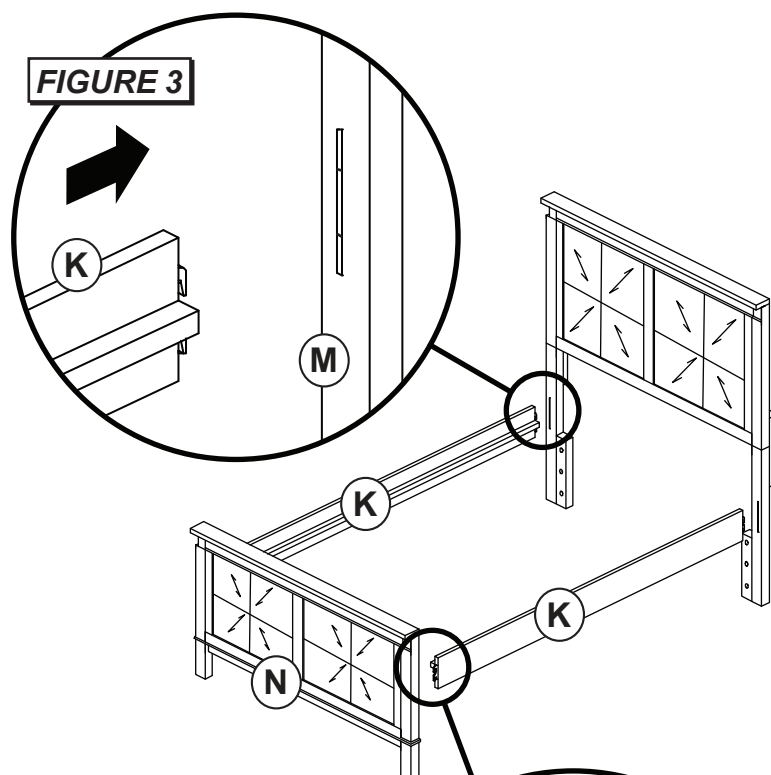


STEP 3 - Figure 3

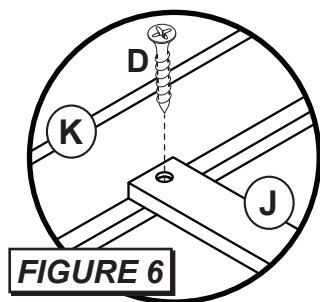
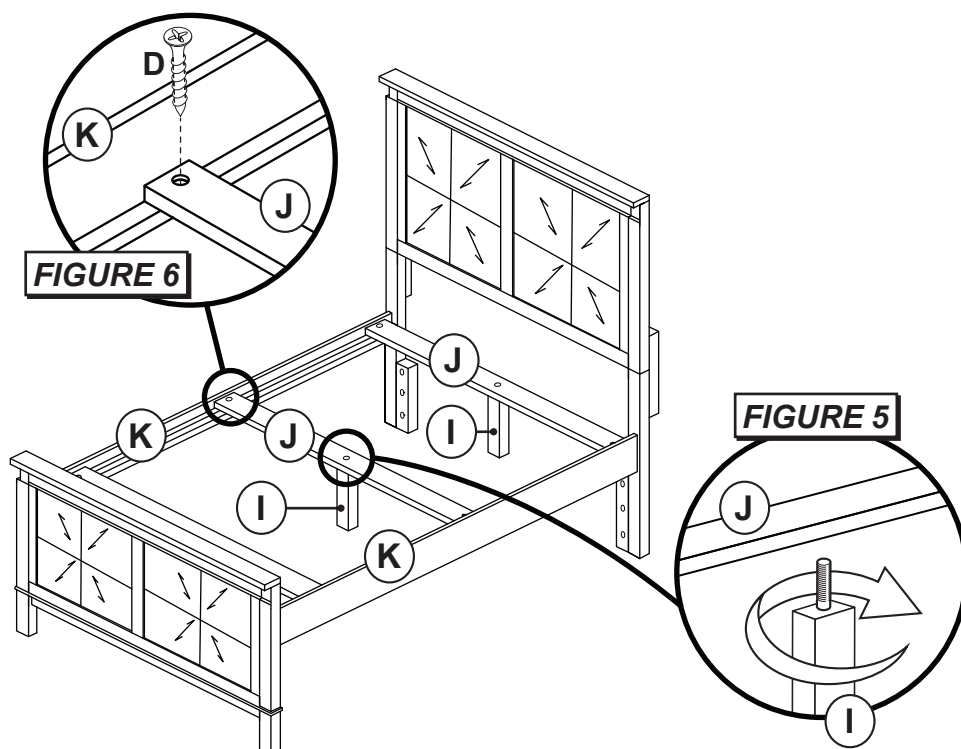
Next attach each Side Rail (K) to each Headboard Leg (M) by inserting the metal teeth into the open slots and pressing in place. Check to make sure each side is secure.

STEP 4 - Figure 4

Also attach each Side Rail (K) to each post on the Footboard Panel (N) by inserting the metal teeth into the open slots and pressing in place. Check to make sure each side is secure.

**STEP 5 - Figure 5**

Attach each Support Foot (I) to the bottom of each Wood Slat (J) by screwing in place. Hand tighten only.

**STEP 6 - Figure 6**

Secure each Wood Slat (J) to the inside of each Side Rail (K) with 1 Wood Screw (D) per end. Tighten screws only using a phillips head screwdriver (not included), but do not over-tighten screws. The assembly is now complete.

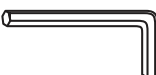

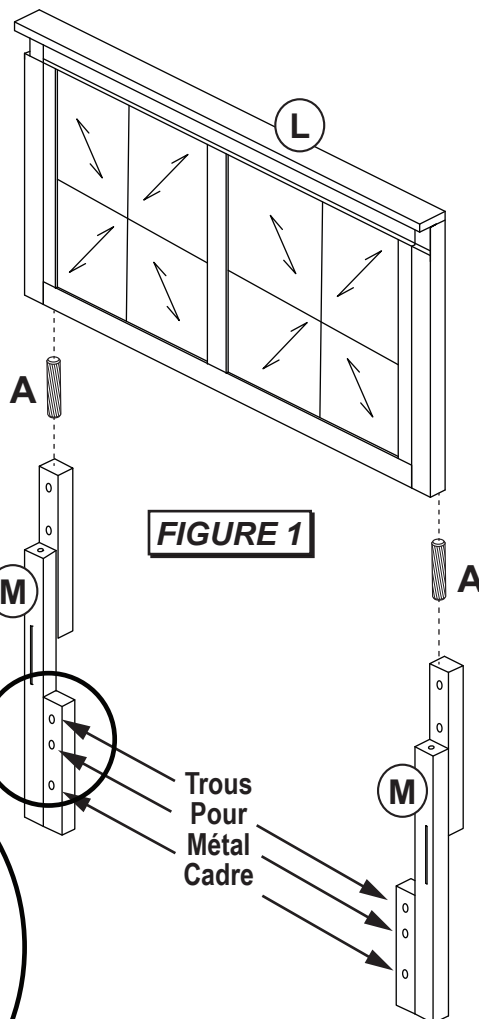

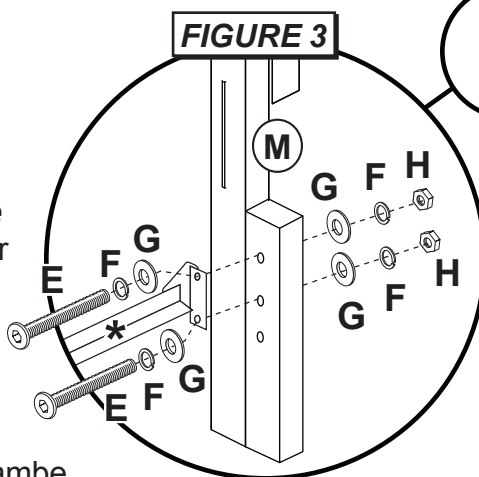
Commencez assemblage en insérant chevilles bois (A) dans les jambes tête de lit (M), puis fixez tête de lit (L) sur le dessus.

Metal Frame (Secure * Non inclus) pour les Jambes tête de lit (M) avec 2 boulons longs (E), 2 Rondelles (F) et 2 rondelles plates (G) à l'avant de chaque jambe et deux rondelles plates (G), 2 rondelles ressort (F) et 2 écrous hexagonaux (H) à l'arrière de chaque jambe.
