#### Hardware Identification





- Insert four WOOD DOWELS (5) to the BOTTOM (B).
- Attach the BOTTOM (B) to the ENDS (C and D), fasten the BOTTOM (B) by using four BOLTS (1).



• Attach the two CONNECTING TUBE (Q) to ENDS (C and D) by using eight BOLTS (2).



- Insert four WOOD DOWELS (5) to the TOP (A).
- Attach the TOP (A) to the ENDS (C and D), tighten four PLASTIC CAM LOCKS.



Fasten the two CONNECTING TUBE (Q) to the TOP (A) by using four BOLTS (3).





Fasten the BACKS (E) to the TOP (A), ENDS (C and D) and the BOTTOM (B) by using sixteen BOLTS (2).

You should start each BOLT a few turns before completely tightening any of them.



◆ Fasten the LEGS (P) to the BOTTOM (B) by using sixteen BOLTS (2).





Slot the DRAWER BOTTOM SUPPORT (O) to the DRAWER FRONT (X).





Fasten the DRAWER BACK (U) to the DRAWER SIDES (S and R) by using six BOLTS (1).
 Repeat the Step 7 and Step 8 on the other drawers.



Use two BOLTS (2) to fasten the PULL (4) to DRAWER FRONT (X).
 Repeat the same on the other drawer.









To insert the DRAWER into your unit, line up the EXTENSION SLIDES on the drawer with the EXTENSION RAILS on the unit and push the drawer into the unit.

Before the drawer is fully inserted, please make sure the interlock pins on the EXTENSION SLIDES on the drawer is pushed forward as shown on the diagram. The drawer should push in hard until it is all the way in , then it will slide in and out easier.

Attention: This unit used Drawer Interlocking System, when one drawer is open, the other drawers cannot be opened.

- Insert four WOOD DOWELS (3) to the BOTTOM (B).

- Insert four WOOD DOWELS (3) to the TOP (A).
- Attach the TOP (A) to the ENDS (C and D), tighten four PLASTIC CAM LOCKS.



- ◆ Fasten the BACK (E) to the TOP (A), ENDS (C and D) and the BOTTOM (B) by using ten BOLTS (2).
- You should start each BOLT a few turns before completely tightening any of them.



Fasten the LEGS (L) to the BOTTOM (B) by using sixteen BOLTS (2).







Slide the DRAWER BOTTOM (K) into the grooves,

in the DRWAER SIDES (O and P), and the DRAWER FRONT (F).



Fasten the DRAWER BACK (J) to the DRAWER SIDES (O and P) by using four BOLTS (1).





◆ Use two BOLTS (2) to fasten the PULL (4) to DRAWER FRONT (F).



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To insert the DRAWER into your unit, line up the EXTENSION SLIDES on the drawer with the EXTENSION RAILS on the unit and push the drawer into the unit until the drawer is fully inserted.

The drawer should push in hard until it is all the way in , then it will slide in and out easier.
