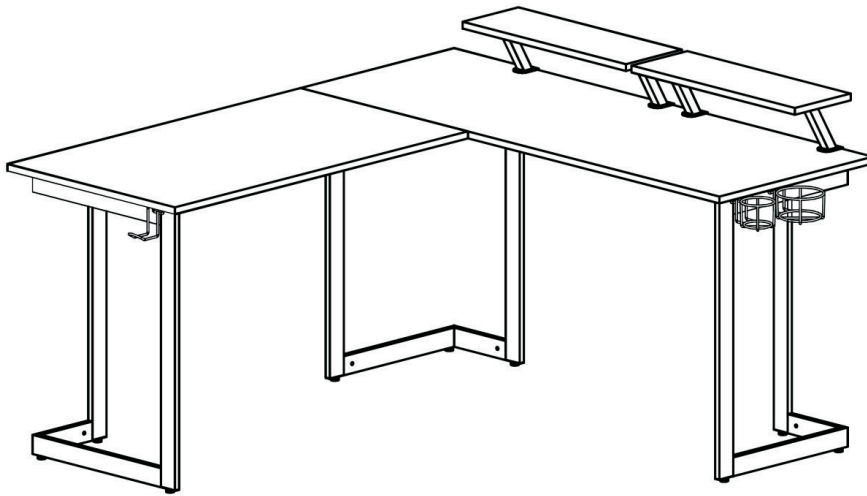


















ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



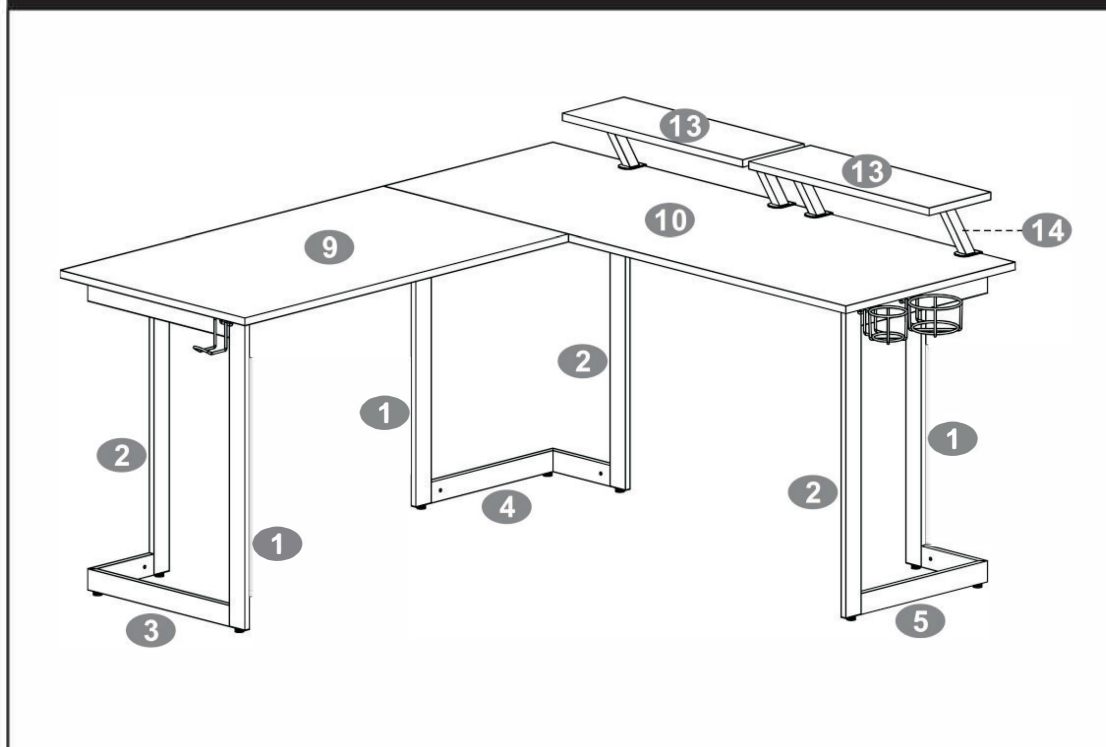
WARNING: To avoid serious personal injury:

- Carefully and strictly follow assembly instructions. Improper assembly of furniture can result in structural failure, instability of the product, or tip-over.
- Monitor and carefully control the assembly components. These include small parts and hardware that may present a choking hazard to small children. Bob's furniture should be assembled only by responsible adults and children should not be involved in the assembly process.
- Where provided, wall mounting hardware should always be used as prescribed in these instructions to anchor furniture to wall. Proper use of the wall mounting hardware can significantly reduce the potential for furniture tip-over and crushing injuries.










BEFORE YOU START THE ASSEMBLY, PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING TIPS AND WARNINGS.

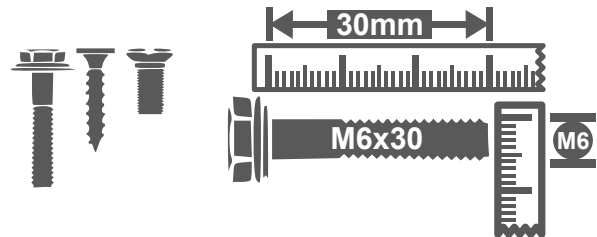
- Do not discard this manual or any of the packaging material until the unit is completely assembled.
- Please read the assembly instructions thoroughly and follow step by step.



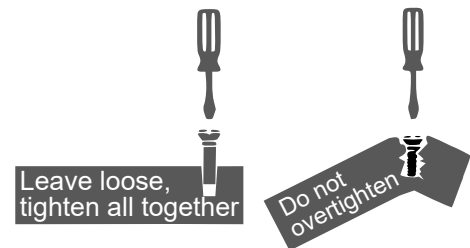
- The assembly might require of 2 persons for certain steps. Before you start the installation, make sure there is someone else nearby to help you.



- Make sure you understand which hardware will be used on each step. Using the wrong size of screw, bolt or pin might strip the threads or cause damage to the part in which it is being used.



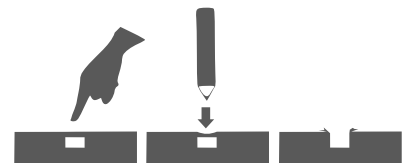
- To avoid misalignments, always leave the screws loosely and do not tighten them until all the pieces are positioned correctly.
- Do not overtighten or force the screws as they might break, strip, damage the threads of the holes, or get stuck inside the parts.



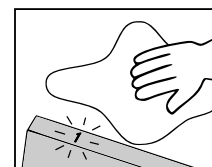
- If the hole seems to small for the screw, make sure you are using the correct size of screw and/or that you are installing it in the correct hole.



- Sometimes on the wood panels the laminate or material might be covering the hole partially or entirely, if there is no visible hole or if it looks too small, pass and press the tip of your finger over the area to feel its indentation, and carefully pierce the laminate to uncover the hole underneath.



- After the item is assembled, you can use rubbing alcohol to erase or remove the visible part numbers printed or labeled on the pieces.



- Please be kind to our planet, when done with the assembly, recycle any of the packaging materials that is accepted by your city or recycling service.

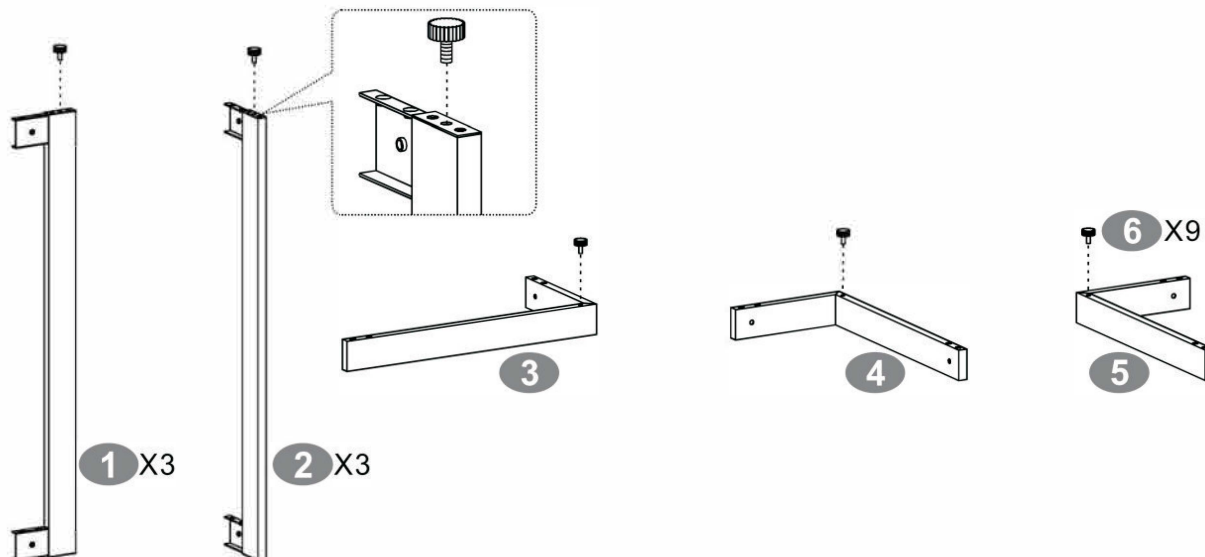

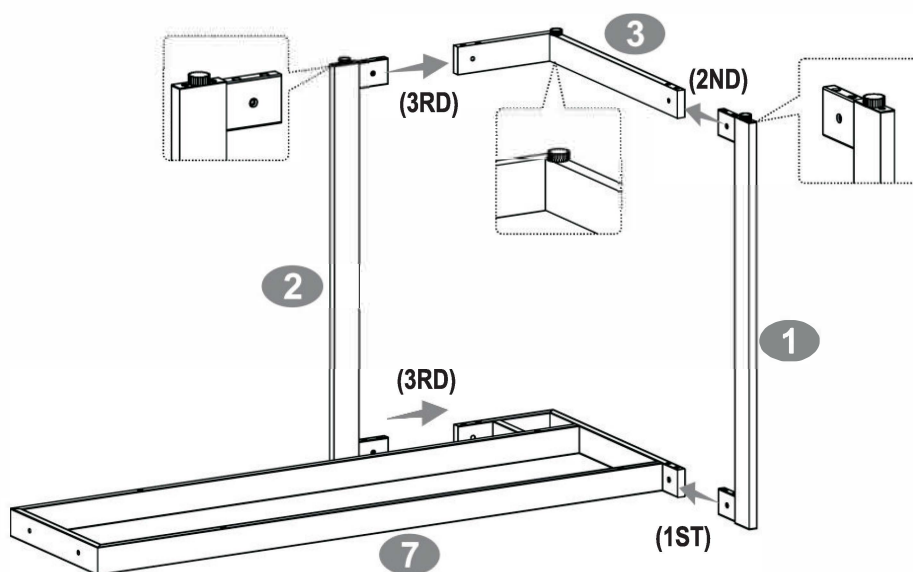


ASSEMBLY STEPS

- 1** Insert the studs (6) to the bottom of the leg structures (1) and (2), and to the corner of each base structure (3), (4) and (5) as shown.



- 2** With the short frame structure (7) oriented as shown, attach the structures as indicated:
 1st: Leg (1) to frame (7).
 2nd: Base (3) to leg (1).
 3rd: Leg (2) to base (3) and frame (7) as shown.

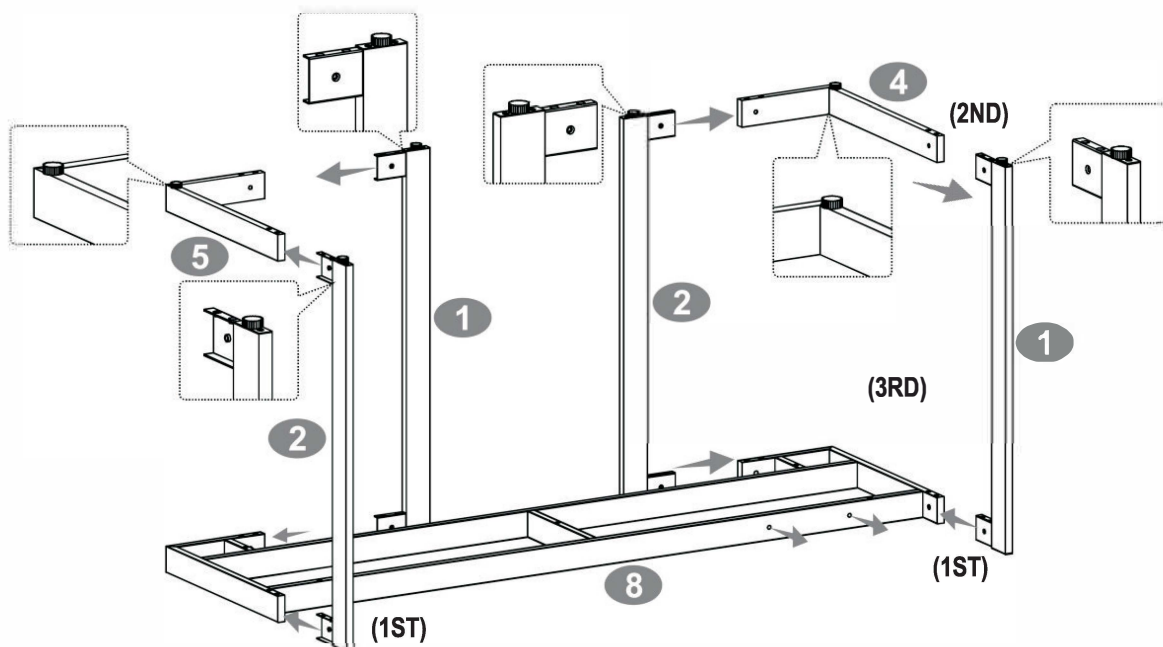
With the long frame structure (8) oriented as shown, attach the structures as indicated:

1st: Leg (1) to frame (8) on the right, and leg (2) to frame (8) on the left;

2nd: Base (4) to leg (1) on the right, and base (5) to leg (2) on the left.

3rd: Leg (2) to base (4) and frame (8) on the right, and leg (1) to base (5) and frame (8) on the left.

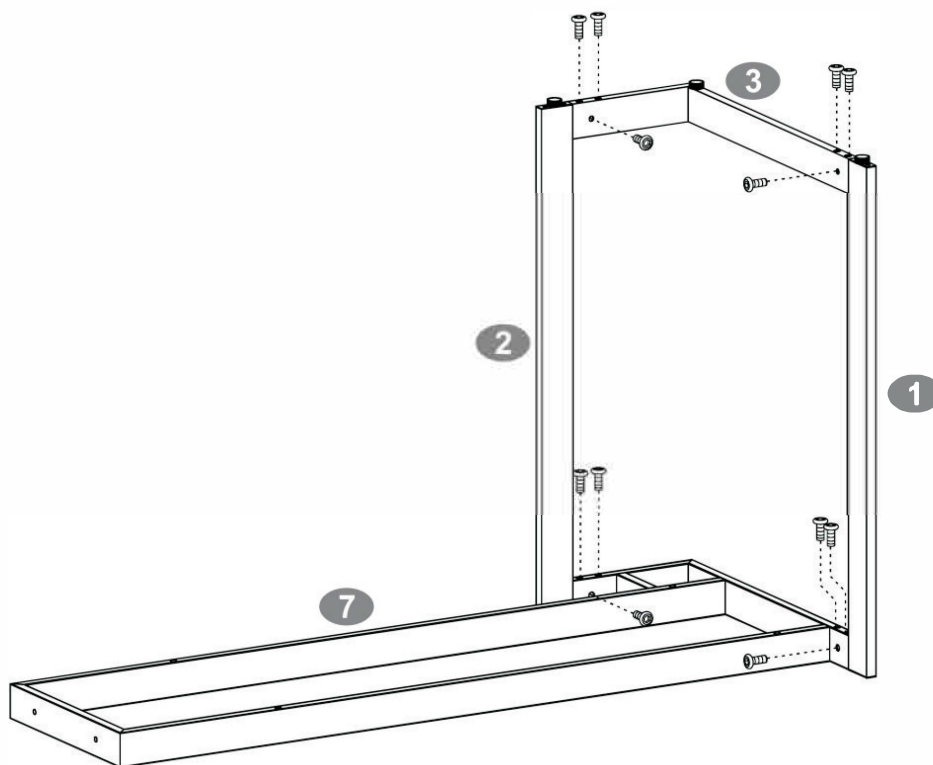
PAY CLOSE ATTENTION TO THE ORIENTATION OF THE PARTS.

Using screws (A), secure the legs (1) and (2) to the base (3) and the frame (7) as shown.

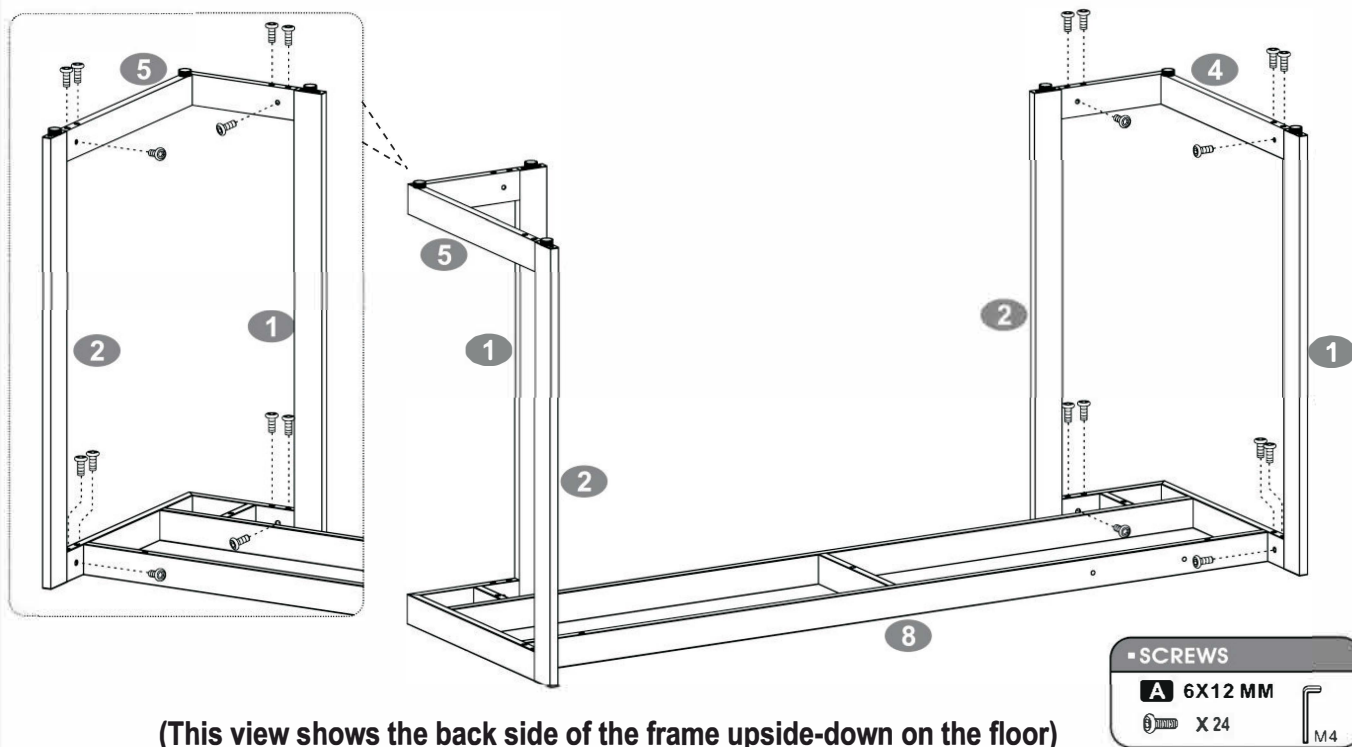


(This view shows the back side of the frame upside-down on the floor)



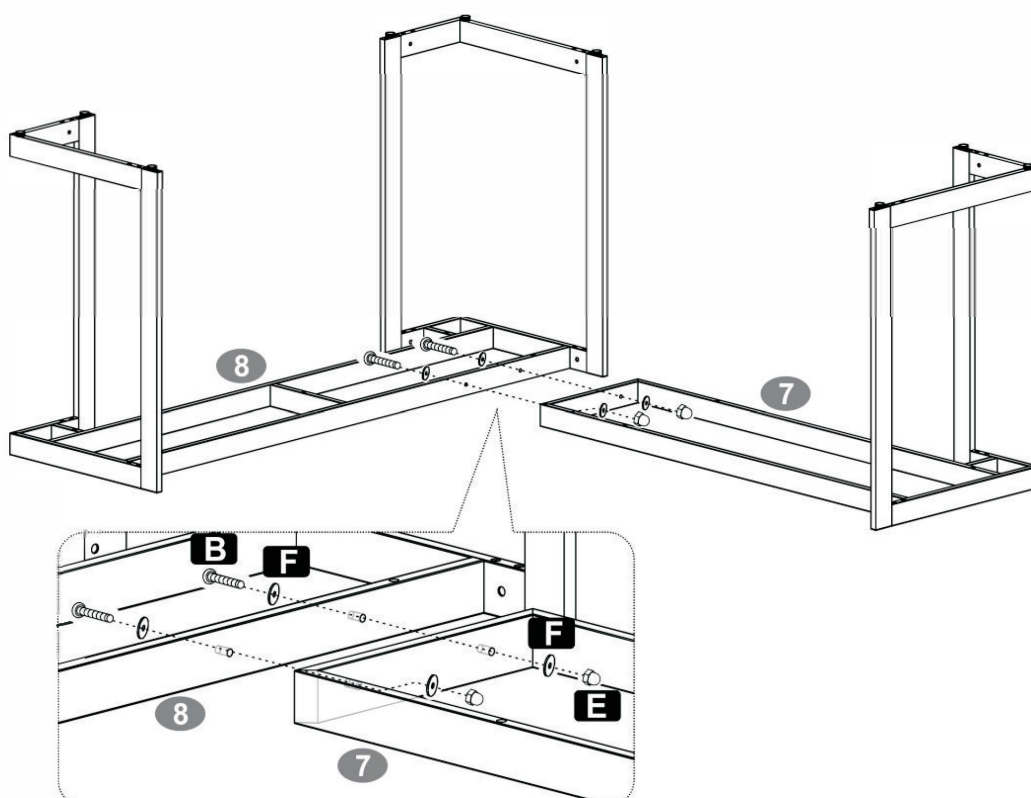

Using screws (B), washers (F) and nut caps (E), assemble the frame (7) to frame (8) as shown.

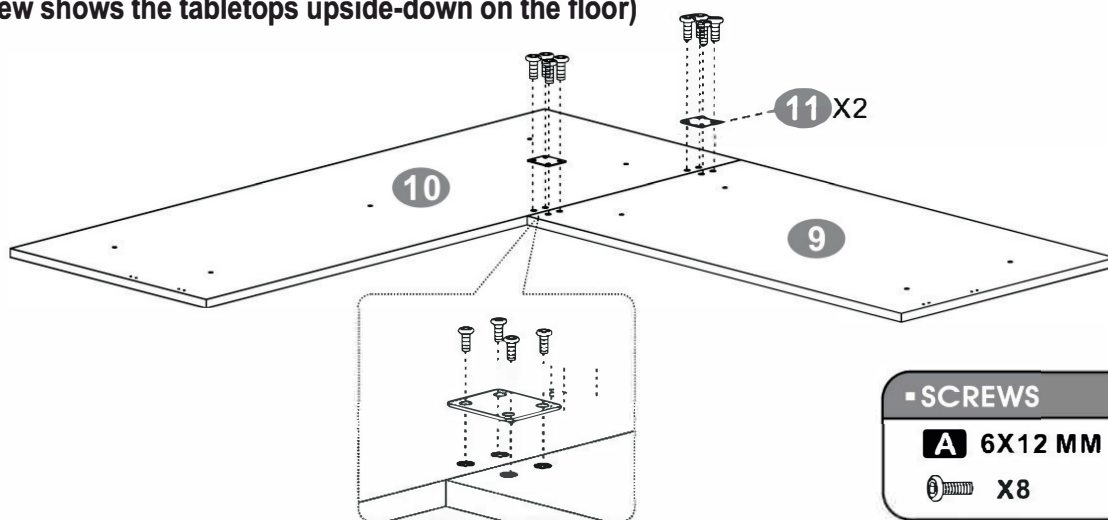

- 7** With the tabletops (9) and (10) upside-down and oriented as shown, attach to them the brackets (11) using screws (A) as shown.

(This view shows the tabletops upside-down on the floor)



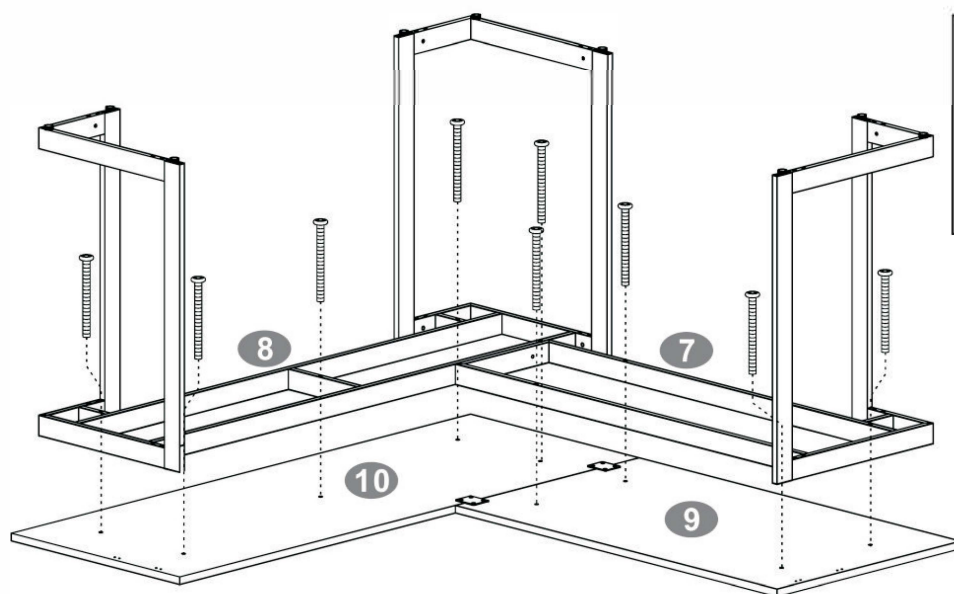

- 8** With the help of another person, place the frame from step 6 upside-down over the tabletops (9) and (10) making the holes coincide, then assemble the frame using screws (C) as shown.



TO AVOID MISALIGNMENTS, FIRST SCREW LOOSELY AND TIGHTEN AFTER ALL THE SCREWS ARE IN PLACE.

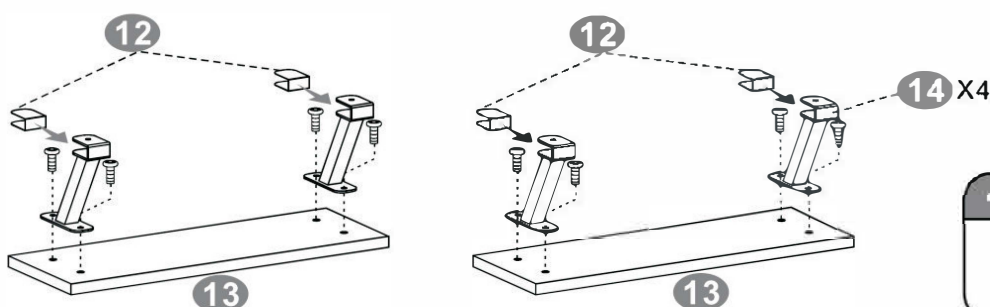

- 9** Assemble the stand support (14) to the stand panel (13) using screws (A), then insert the protectors from the fixing set (12) in the supports as shown.

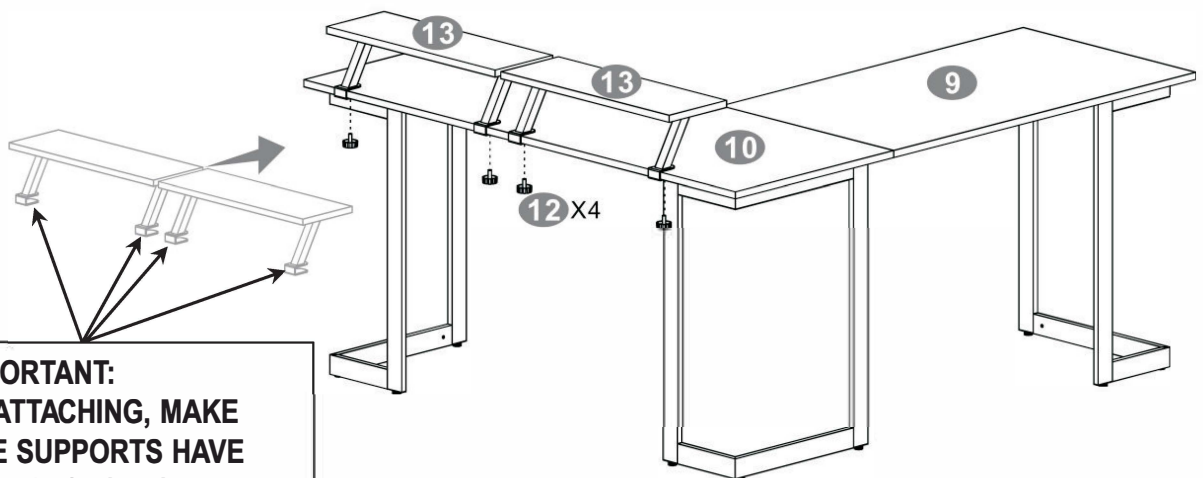

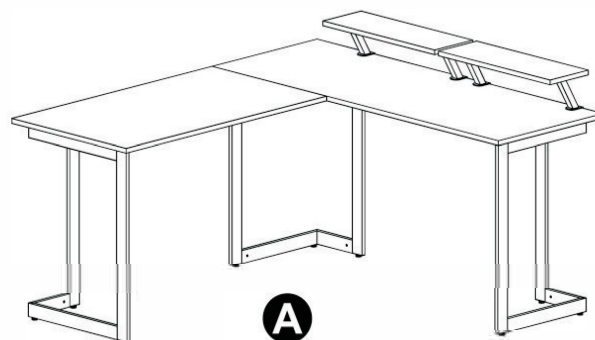

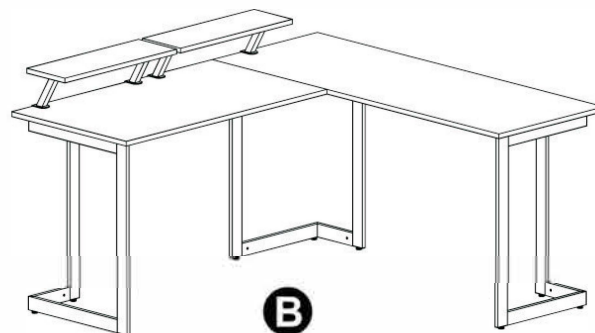
(This view shows the unit upright and from its back)

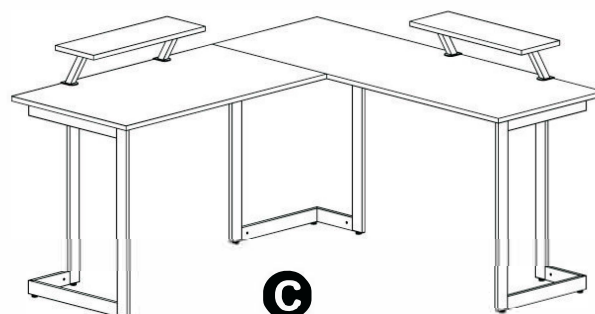

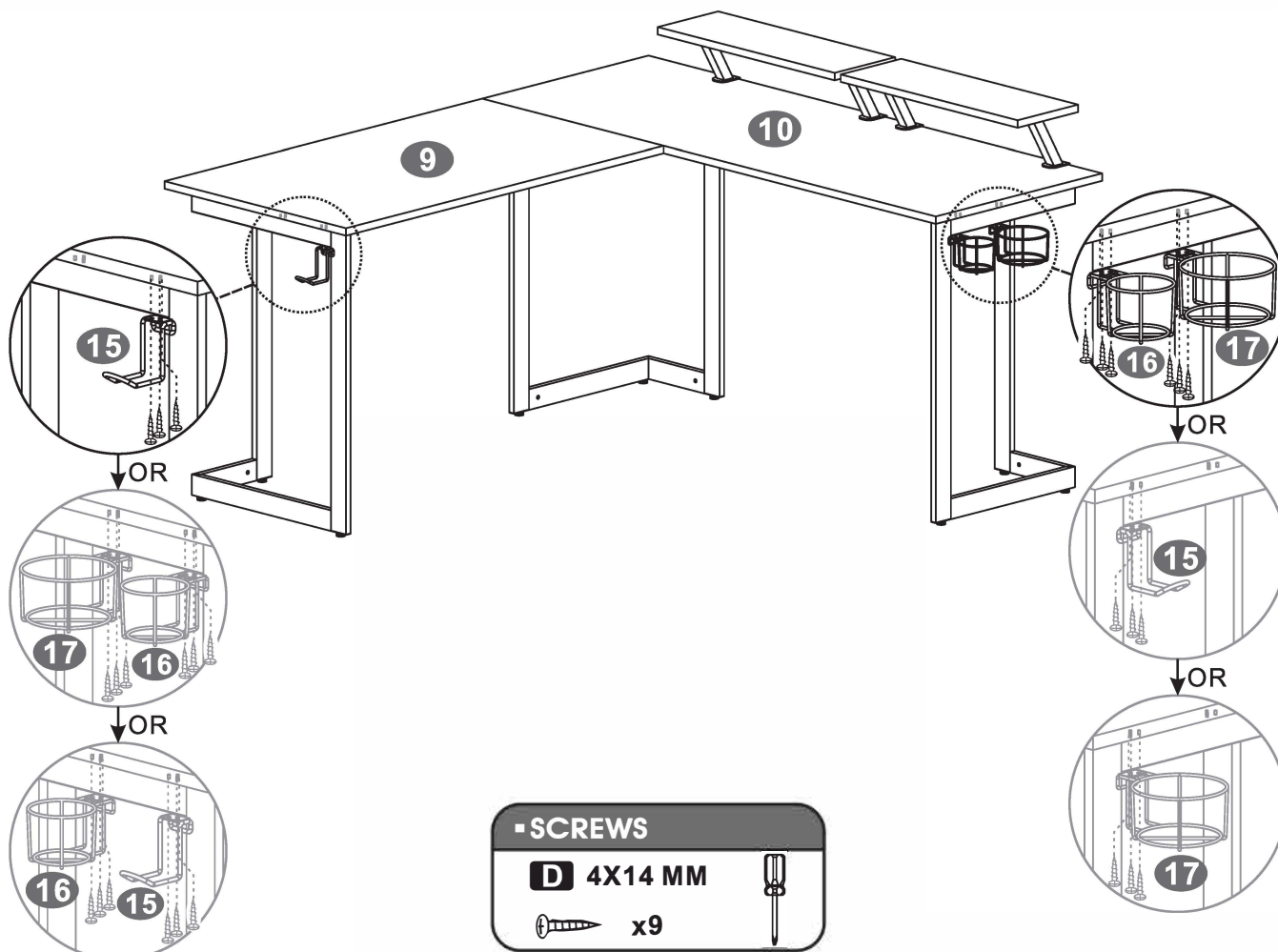

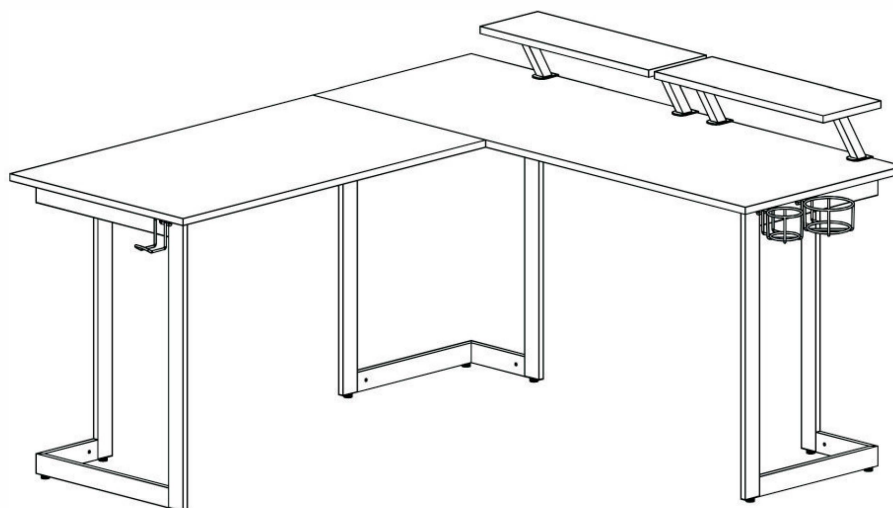

Using screws (D), assemble on either side and from underneath the tabletops (9) and (10), the earphones hanger (15), the small cup holder (16), and the large cup holder (17).

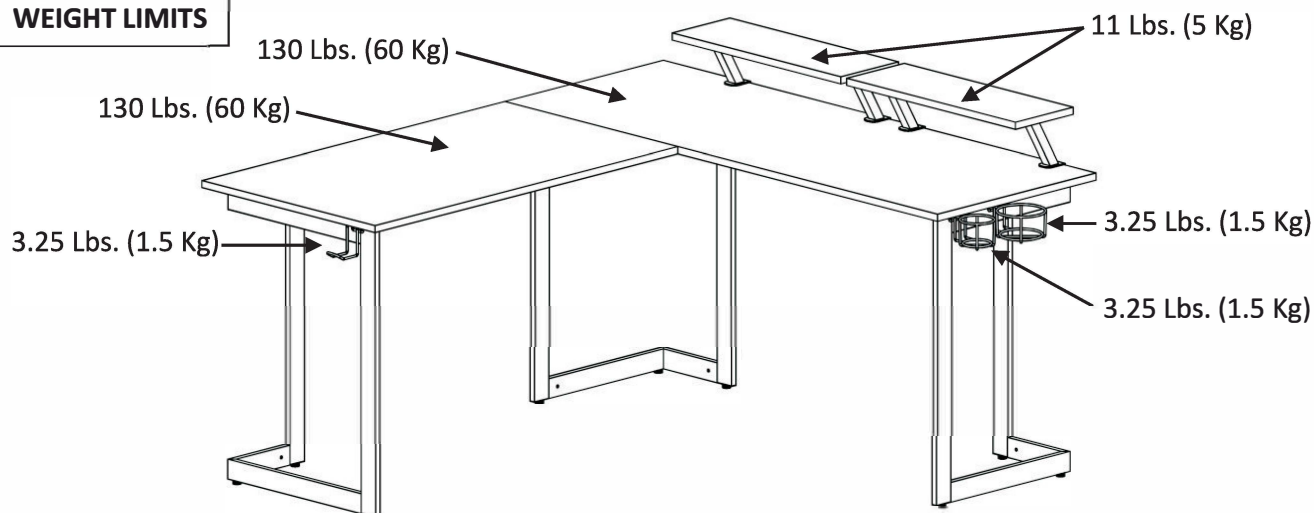

CARE AND MAINTENANCE WARNINGS:**

WEIGHT LIMITS



- Do not exceed the indicated weight limits.
- Do not expose the surfaces to direct sunlight or to extreme environmental conditions.
- Clean the surfaces preferable with a clean cloth dampened in a solution of mild soap and water, then dry with a clean towel.
- Do not use solvents or abrasive materials to clean the unit.
- If you decide to use a cleaning agent, test first on an area hidden from view such as underneath the tabletops.
- Do not seat on the unit or lean against it.
- Do not allow small children to play on or below the unit, or with the stand shelves or the accessories.
- The unit must be handled by at least 2 persons when moving in the same or adjacent rooms, preferable 3 persons: 2 holding the ends and 1 holding the corner.
- Before moving the unit, make sure to remove any object that is heavy or might fall off, and try to handle it from their structures. Lifting from the tabletops alone might put too much stress on the screws which can lead to part damage/separation.
- When lifting the unit, use both hands and bend your knees, not your backs.
- When transporting the unit to places far away, protect and secure the unit to avoid damage in transit.
- The warranty does not extend to regular wear and tear, nor the manufacturer assumes liability for damages or consequences due to accidents, incorrect assembly, negligence, improper use, modifications, or not heeding the above warnings.
